CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT**

(in accordance with DPR 235/2007 and the agreement Protocol set up to guarantee the start of the school year in due regard for the safety rules to control the spread of COVID19)

PART ONE

Schools have the aim of promoting the education of every student within their learning environment, contributing to the development of all dimensions of his/her personality and above all to a proper social interaction and the awareness of his/her personal and social growth. The internalisation of the rules can continue to happen only with an effective collaboration on the part of the families. Our school therefore pursues the objective of building an educational partnership with the pupils' parents and a mutual trusting relationship, through constant relations respecting each other's roles, in order to strengthen the aims of the Educational Offer and guide the pupils and boarders in their human and personal growth to educational success.

The Convitto undertakes to:

- create a serene and appropriate environment, encouraging the development of knowledge and skills, the maturation of behaviours and values, the support in different skills, the help and guidance in situations of distress, the fighting against all kinds of prejudice and exclusion
- carry out the national educational curricula based on educational, methodological and pedagogical choices ensuring everyone's right to learn
- assess the pupils' progress in a suitable and clear way, in accordance with the didactic activities and individual learning rhythms
- communicate constantly with the families, as to the results, the difficulties, progresses, commitment to study in the different school subjects, as well as regarding behaviour and conduct
- regularly and confidentially listen and pay attention to the pupils' and boarders' problems so as to favour pedagogical and educational interaction with the families

The Boarder undertakes to:

- encourage the correct performance of all proposed activities, guaranteeing attention and active participation
- comply with the Boarding School Regulations
- transmit/share with your family members/guardians all communications coming from the Boarding School and the School
- respect the web network and the technological tools rules of use (in particular security and privacy) during the possible performance of distance learning activities

The family undertakes to:

- establish a constructive dialogue with the teachers and educators, respecting their assessment competence and educational choices
- keep up-to-date on commitments, deadlines, school initiatives by daily checking the means of communication between the boarding school and the families (circular letters, electronic register) and taking part in the parents' meetings

- support the teachers and educators in their educational actions aiming at the internalisation of rules and the compliance with the instructions given
- make sure, through frequent contact with teachers and instructors, that the pupil/boarder is following the study commitments and the school rules in an active and responsible way
- take action with awareness and responsibility in case of any damage caused by their child at the expense of persons, furnishings, didactic material and structures, including recovery and compensation of the damage

PART TWO

(Health agreement)

Schools must be a safe place as regards the health of all people involved both for work and for learning; in particular, referring to the constitutional principles, for the weakest and most fragile people involved.

In order to reach this aim, our school must therefore implement educational, training and prevention measures ensuring the minimization of risk of diseases and the prevention of the spread of viruses and pathogenic agents that are dangerous for human beings. Particularly in line with the Ministerial guidelines of the Technical-Scientific Committee and the Local Health Authorities,

The Convitto undertakes to:

- adopt a specific Organisation Plan consistent with the current context, that specifies the actions implemented for handling the health emergency situation due to Covid-19
- guarantee safety and appropriate sanitary conditions in all the rooms and areas where school and educational activities take place
- organize and implement information actions for the entire school and boarder community and staff training to prevent Covid-19 infections
- ensure the school and educational activities occur safely, including – coherently with the school environment and organization, and in agreement with the competent authorities - distance learning if necessary
- encourage the opportunities of sharing public health goals so as to promote co-responsibility between school and educational staff, boarders, students and families
- ensure maximum openness regarding administrative acts, clarity and timeliness in notifications, including the use of computer facilities and in respect of privacy
- monitor the correct application of behaviour rules, regulations and prohibitions in accordance with the measures taken by the competent Authorities

The Boarder undertakes to:

- read the Organization Plan for handling the health emergency situation due to Covid-19 and undertake to comply with all aspects regarding him/her (with particular reference to the rights and obligations regarding individual and public health)
- comply with all the behaviour regulations, rules and prohibitions defined by the competent Authorities and by the Head of the Boarding School, with particular reference to the social distancing, use of protective equipment (face masks etc.), personal hygiene, disinfection of contact surfaces, compliance with any requirements and shifts in school hours and canteen hours, use of common areas, carrying out of periodic control tests, and specific arrangements when entering and leaving the school building

The family undertakes to:

- read the Organization Plan for handling the health emergency situation due to Covid-19 and undertake to comply with all aspects regarding them (with particular reference to the rights and obligations regarding individual and public health)
- endorse and support the School's indications with a positive collaboration mindset to guarantee the safe carrying out of all school activities
- comply with and apply all the indications preventing infection from Covid-19 in the school's Organisation Plan and according to Ministerial and competent Authorities' decisions, with particular reference to the daily measurement of their child's temperature before entering school, the supply of protective equipment (face masks, hand sanitizer, etc.), the taking of a coronavirus test before arrival
- be always (24/7) available and reachable by phone for possible urgent notifications and **for the pick-up of the boarder within 6 hours after receiving notification by the school** in case of symptoms similar to those of Covid-19 or of other infective diseases that can endanger the health of other boarders, removal/expulsion for disciplinary reasons or sudden closure of the boarding school for reasons of force majeure
- in case the family lives abroad or in a region from which it is not possible to reach the Convitto within 6 hours, identify a trusted adult who can pick up the boarder in the cases stated above
- facilitate the execution of periodic coronavirus testing on the boarder
- make sure the boarder observes the school arrival and leaving times and attends classes assiduously, both in class and with distance learning
- actively participate in school life by regularly looking at the school's website and the electronic register

The parent, having read the rules that the school considers as being fundamental for a proper civil coexistence, signs for acceptance and commits himself/herself to this Educational and Health Co-responsibility Agreement which is valid for the whole course of studies of his/her son/daughter.
